INTRODUCTION

NJ SMART introduced the Career and Technical Education (CTE) Submission in the 2009-2010 School Year. The CTE Submission collects a set of data elements that provide a more comprehensive picture of students that are enrolled in CTE programs. The collection of this data at the student level allows for improved data quality and capacity for CTE administrators and stakeholders. **The CTE Submission is required for all Local Education Agencies (LEAs) that have a Career and Technical Education program.**
